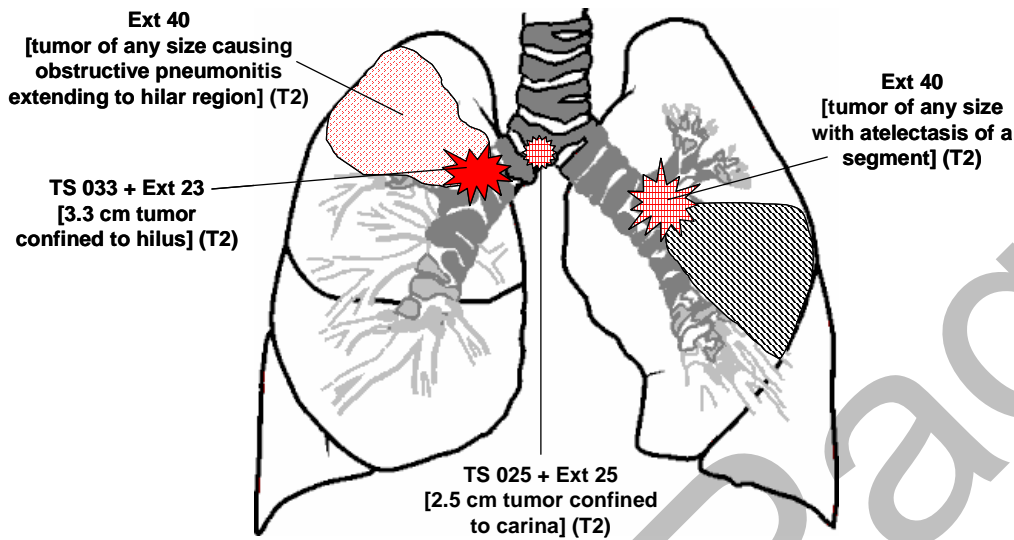


Figure 15. Examples of Tumor Sizes and Extension Codes 23, 25 and 40 Combinations with TNM T-Category Mapping (each lesion represents a single tumor)



CS Extension (Figures 14-19)

- CS Extension has a number of notes carried forward from summary staging, SEER Extent of Disease, and TNM.
- Record the farthest extension of the primary tumor, whether clinically determined or pathologic.
- Note 1 describes certain structures that are metastatic and are to be coded in CS Mets at Dx.
- For Code 20, refer to Note 2: Assume tumor is more than 2 cm from carina if lobectomy, segmental resection, or wedge resection is done. Two centimeters is the minimum amount of uninvolved mainstem bronchus needed by the surgeon to close off the bronchus during a pneumonectomy.
- For Codes 40 and 55, refer to Note 4: “Bronchopneumonia” is not the same thing as “obstructive pneumonitis” and should not be coded as such.
